What Is A Bequest?

A will also enables you to remember special causes or good friends that you have supported in your lifetime.

How do I make a Will?

Yeshivah Centre is an organisation primarily about families. Hence, we strongly encourage our bequestors(check if there is such a word)to look after their family first in their Will. We suggest you talk over your wishes with your family, and with a professional such as a lawyer or trustee company, before making your Will, so that your beneficiaries receive the maximum advantage from your bequest.

By letting Yeshivah Centre know that you intend to include us in your bequest, you give us an opportunity to properly acknowledge your generosity within your lifetime. We will also keep you up to date with current developments and share with you news of our on-going achievements and those we can look forward to.
